- ◆ District Conference – May 4-7<sup>th</sup>. The club has 5 couples attending. We have a table reserved for promoting our club. We will display information on our international projects, website, and club bulletins.
- ◆ Prayer Breakfast – Volunteers are needed to set-up on May 3<sup>rd</sup>. We will have information on the table regarding the club
- ◆ District Assembly - At Chapman University on May 20<sup>th</sup>. Need signup sheet and money sent to District.

**Community Service Don Wile for Dick Paradzick**

- ◆ Tree Planting – still gathering information on the replanting of the trees at Rotary Grove.
- ◆ Laura's House – Sunday, April 30<sup>th</sup>, 8 am to 3 pm. Don has a list of supplies that are need for the repairs and he will buy the supplies then split the cost with Lions and Kiwanis clubs.
- ◆ Latch Key Kids of Mission Viejo - The City as offered to match funds of the money collected. We will look at splitting the cost between Lions and Kiwanis if the cost if large.

**Vocational Service: Bob McQueen**

- ◆ AFS (America Field Service) – The students will come and speak to the club on May 9<sup>th</sup> regarding their experiences.
- ◆ Bookmarks – Someone in our district has borrowed the die cut and we need to find out whom so we can have additional bookmark made.

- ◆ RI Charitable Foundation – Bob McQueen signed 70 letters that went to the volunteers who participated in the principal-for-a-day program, to alert them of the 501C operations of RI.
