## REPORT FROM OUR BOARD OF DIRECTORS

### PRESIDENT'S REPORT (Ross Boling)

Budget for 2003/2004: Boling presented the first draft of a proposed budget. Each line item was presented for discussion. The Directors discussed the budget and presented questions for possible revisions. Boling continued the discussion of the Budget to the September 2003 Meeting

### CLUB SERVICE: (Steve Mugg)

South County Chamber of Commerce: This item was continued from last month's meeting. Boling presented report on behalf of Jim Leach. Cost to Club to join Chamber is \$235 annual dues. There are no other financial requirements. Club would gain access to business listings of the Chamber and can promote Rotary Membership and Fund Raising Projects to members of the Chamber. Boling assured the Directors that the individual privacy of Rotarians would be protected and no club roster would be given to the Chamber. Rotarians who attend Chamber meetings or functions would do so at their own cost and expense. After discussion it was MSC to join the Chamber and pay the first years dues.

Bank Accounts: Boling reported that the Club has several Certificates that will soon mature. Boling appointed Tipping and Kersten to review the maturities, investigate current investment options and report back to the Board.

### VOCATIONAL SERVICE: (Jerry Gross)

Mission Viejo High School Interact Club-Boling reported that the school representative, Marilyn, is also the MUN advisor. It is hoped that Marilyn will serve as Interact advisor. McQueen and Gross working with school on the program

### INTERNATIONAL SERVICE (Rich Frieder):

Poona India Partner Club-Boling reported that he recommends increase in budget from \$1,000 to \$2,000 for the Cleft Lip Project. Frieder presented correspondence from the Poona Club wherein they request the right to devote our contribution to worthy projects as they see fit. Such projects include: at risk pregnancy and other health related needs. After discussion the Board moved to earmark \$1,000 to Cleft Lip project and \$1,000 to general health fund in Poona

### COMMUNITY SERVICE (Verl Nash)

McQueen gave directions to the three Food Banks that our club supports Women helping Women-Boling recommended a donation of \$500 to WHW to purchase clothing in needed sizes. After discussion it was MSC to donate \$500.

Walk against Drugs: Boling reported that we may need to increase funds for this project. Date is set for October 18<sup>th</sup>.

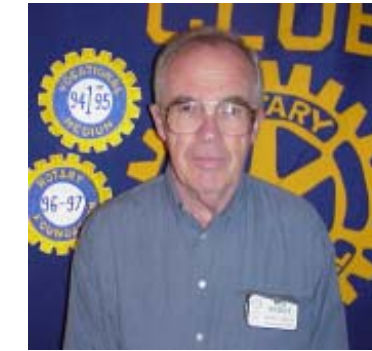
Pancake Breakfast: Date is October 12<sup>th</sup>. Proceeds are directed to Esperanza School and Special Olympics
