The float is funded entirely by voluntarily contributions from Rotary Clubs and Rotarians throughout the United States and Canada. Rotarians together with members of Rotaract and Interact clubs donate their time and effort to decorate the float. Over 425 million people see the Rose Parade New Year's Day with an estimated U.S. audience of 90 million people and an estimated international audience of more than 325 million in over 100 countries.
