NEW MEDICAL PROJECTS

Dr. Khan now proposes to perform surgery on a large number of young children who have defective urinary opening and deformed penis, a condition called hypospadias. It is a major surgery which requires hospitalization for 8 to 10 days and expenses are around Rs. 15,000/- Rs.20,000/- Dr Khan feels that as a part of the Rotary programme we should be able to do the entire procedure in Rs.5,000/ to Rs.6,000/

In this endeavour the Poona Club acknowledges and thanks us for our contribution allowing Dr. Khan to carry on his good work for Rotary.

Ramesh will be in touch with Dr. Khan as above and will keep you informed. We have another contributor and active Ann Dr. Pratibha Kataria who is updating us regarding her projects which will also be reported to Mission Viejo rotary.
