“This is the 2 story building which was once an elementary school. We are painting the lunch room and will use it for serving lunch to 50 children. We will use the building for distributing the food packages, powdered milk, and all other assistance. I was able to buy some peanut butter when i was in Bogota and we are handing out PBJ’s to children every Friday afternoon. There is also a garden section where we hope to grow vegetables.
