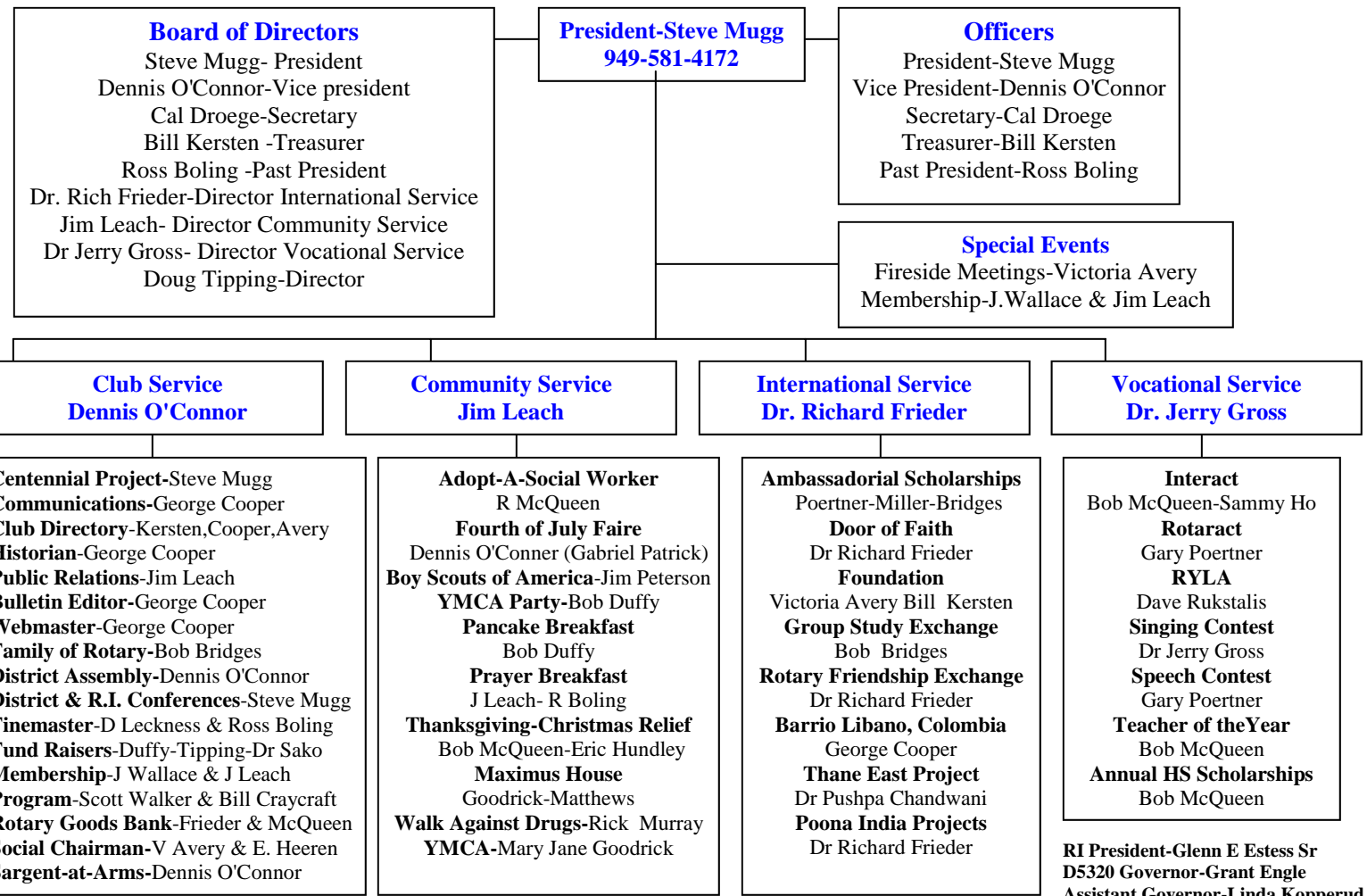

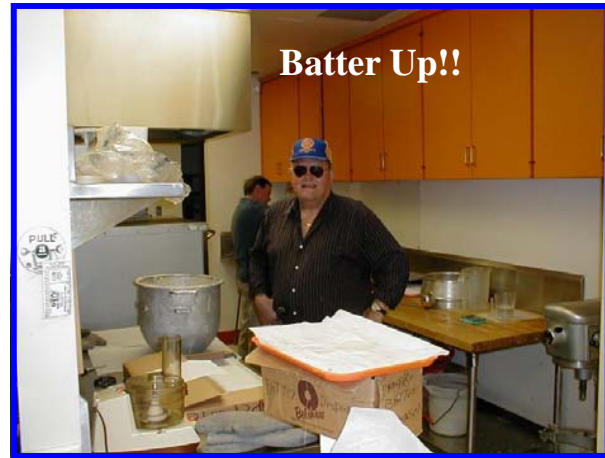

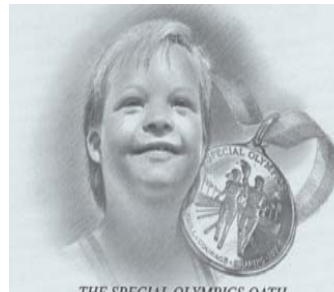


WORLD COMMUNITY SERVICE MATCHING GRANT REPORT
